Rules Concerning the Summer School

§1. Aims of the Summer School

- 1. The Summer School is designed for Master Students and it is a mandatory part of the Master's Program in Public Administration of TSU in cooperation with the German University of Administrative Sciences Speyer. After the successful completion of the Summer School course, the MA student gets 4 ECTS.
- 2. The Summer School aims to give students deep and systematic knowledge about the different kinds and competences of public administration on different levels (municipal, regional, federal & EU). Emphasis will be given to the Germany as an example of one of the EU Countries, with federal state structure.
- 3. During the Summer School the seminar takes place, where methodology and also individual issues concerning the content of the Master Thesis are discussed. Furthermore, students will attend the presentation concerning technical issues and ways of preparation of the Master Thesis.
- 4. During the Summer School the submission of the report about the Internships abroad and its presentation also takes place.

§2. Duration

Duration of the Summer School is 2 calendar weeks.

§3.Location of the Summer School

Summer School takes place at the University of Speyer. If it is considered appropriate, it may be carried out elsewhere in the future.

§4. Evaluation

Student's evaluation will be based on: Attendance - $30\,\%$ Oral participation - $30\,\%$ Final presentations - $40\,\%$

§5. Transitional Provisions

The following provisions were elaborated by the Academic Council of the program. The decisions of the Council are presented to the Council of the Faculty of Law for approve/cancelation/changes and afterwards it is forwarded to the Academic Council of TSU and enters into force in the moment it is approved.
